## REGISTRATION:

Registration forms are available at MCHS, SGCHS or SGCHS Outreach and on-line.

All completed registration forms must include a **non-refundable** registration fee of \$50.00 payable to Parkland School Division. Registrations will be accepted until Wednesday, June 21, 2017.

M.C.H.S. reserves the right to cancel any class for which the **minimum enrollment** is NOT reached. You will receive a telephone call if the course does not run and your cheque(s) will be returned.

**PLEASE ATTACH A COPY OF THE STUDENT'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE TO THE REGISTRATION FORM!**

Alberta Education regulations regarding pre-requisites for a course apply to Summer School. As an example, if you are registered for English 20-1, you must provide proof of having passed or are currently taking English 10-1 (such as an interim report card or transcript). See the back of your registration form for a list of courses and course pre-requisites.

Special Accommodations for writing exams must be approved by MCHS Principal and addressed by the Special Needs Coordinator.

One Summer School course is a full-time program. The course load is equivalent to that of a **five-month** semester. In general, expect homework each day to prepare for your next class.

## BOOK DEPOSIT:

All registration forms must include a cheque payable to Parkland School Division for a book deposit fee in the amount of \$50.00. A book deposit is not required for students taking CALM, Phys Ed, Construction Technology (\$70.00), or Work Experience. This book deposit fee will be held in the school office until the end of Summer School. Once the textbook or novel(s) are returned to the teacher at the end of Summer School, the student will be handed back the book deposit cheque. Failure to hand in any textbook or novel(s), will result in the book deposit cheque being cashed immediately.

## ATTENDANCE:

Each day of Summer School instruction is the equivalent of one week of a semestered high school program. Full attendance is required and is essential for success! Due to the already abbreviated nature of Summer School, no provisions will be made for missed classes, late starts or early releases. You are expected to attend every class as scheduled and you must be in attendance on the last day of class (July 28th) to write the final exam.

## WITHDRAWALS:

Students withdrawing on or before July 7th will not receive a final mark on their transcript.

## FINAL EXAMINATIONS:

In all courses, final examinations will be held on the last day of class. Final examinations cannot be rescheduled.
