***French for the Future National Essay Contest***- Scholarships, valued between \$1,000 and \$12,000, are open to students in grades 10 to 12. ***Burger King Scholars Program***- Scholarships ranging from \$1000 - \$50,000 are available to graduating students who intend to pursue college, university or post-secondary vocational / technical school.
