Diploma Exams

- Fixed dates
- ✓ Grade 12 English, Social Studies, Math 30-1-2, Science, Chemistry, Biology and Physics
- ✓ Worth 30% of a final grade in a course
- English, Social Studies, consist of a:
 - Part A Written (15%)
 - Part B Multiple choice (15%)
- Length varies, must stay for a minimum of one hour

Graduation List Requirements

To participate in the Graduation Ceremony, a student must:

- Meet the minimum course credit requirements for an Alberta High School Diploma/KAE Certificate
- In each semester, students must have earned at least 50% as a final grade in any required diploma examination subjects.
- In Semester 2, students must have earned at least 50% in the school awarded mark by the April PowerSchool Update (April 26).
- Registration in Summer School <u>does not</u> qualify students for participation in the graduation exercises.

The initial Grad list will posted and updated throughout the school year until May 31st.

The final Grad list will be posted May 31st, 2024.

If a student's grades fall below 50% in <u>any</u> course required for graduation, the student's name will be removed from the Graduation List.

Students enrolled in AAC/CFL must meet the following requirements:

- A minimum of 75% completed in a 5 credit course by May 30 and passing.
- A minimum of 75% completed in a 3 credit course by May 30 and passing.
- An average greater than 50% in any courses required for a diploma as of May 30.

Students enrolled in another institute must adhere to the same timelines as above and must advise their Grade Administrator of any courses in which they are enrolled/completed at campuses other than Memorial or CFL.

Students will be removed from the Graduation List as a result of:

- Failing marks in required courses (below 50%).
- Incomplete courses among Graduation requirements.
- Insufficient graduation requirements (courses dropped or missing).
- Failure to attend classes.



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


