Rotary Club of Parkland After Dark Scholarship - \$1300 scholarship is available for a graduating high school student entering their first year of post-secondary education (including registered apprenticeships). Remax Quest for Excellence Program – Grade 12 students can earn a \$1000 bursary to be used towards further education. WISEST Summer Research Program – This program is for **Grade 11 students** who want to learn first-hand about trail-blazing fields of study, research and diverse careers. Canadian Agri-Business Education Foundation Scholarship - Six \$2500 scholarships are awarded annually to Canadian grade 12 students who are entering into an accredited agriculture college or university.
